



CANCELLATION TIMELINE:

Enrolled campers wishing to cancel registration have the following options:

- 1) By April 15, 2021: Receive a full refund of fees paid.
- 2) Between April 16-May 16, 2021: 50% refund if cancelled.
- 3) By May 17, 2021: Roll over registration fee paid to a 2022 session.
- 4) After May 17, 2021: No refund available.

If Camp is cancelled due to local health guidelines beyond the control of Friends of Camp Concord or Camp Concord, a full refund will be provided or fees can be rolled over to 2022.

No refunds will be given once a camper has checked in for camp.

COVID-19:

- » If a camper receives a positive COVID-19 test within 72 hours of departure a full refund will be given.
- » If a camper needs to depart camp early because of COVID-19 symptoms, no refund will be provided.
- » If a camper is required to leave before the conclusion of their camp session due to COVID-19 exposure no refund will be given.

MEDICAL CONDITIONS:

- » If for any reason the camper cannot attend due to a medical condition contact the Youth Camp Coordinator at youthcamp@friendsofcampconcord.org.



LICE:

- » If your child is determined within 48 hours of camp to have lice and you are unable to make arrangements for treatment, a refund will not be given. If you are able to notify the Youth Camp Coordinator 48 hours or more prior to bus loading, a 50% refund will be given.
- » If, at check in day of camp, lice is discovered on a camper during the lice check before they board the bus, they will not be able to board the bus. No refund will be given. Please refer to Lice Policy for more information.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE BEHAVIOR CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT:

- » If a camper does not comply with the Behavior Code of Conduct and is asked to leave, no refund will be given. Please refer to the Behavior Code of Conduct for more information.
